- A) ACT reading score of 19, SAT reading score of 330, Next-Gen ACCUPLACER reading score of 248.
- B) ACT numerical score of 19, SAT math score of 510, or ALEKS score of 14 or higher.
- C) Satisfy "Iowa Core Performance Standards".
- D) Standardized placement scores must be current (completed within 24 months) at time of enrollment.
- E) Must successfully complete a course in Anatomy and Physiology Essentials with a grade of "C" or above.
- F) Students will be required to pass a mandatory background check.
- G) Students will be required to submit (at their own expense) a completed physical examination form and immunizations.

All health career programs require students to earn a grade of "C" (2.0) or above in all coursework within the program. All other eligibility requirements must be met.
